Roadworks at Prestonkirk – work is being done to widen the pavement on Preston Road outside Prestonkirk and also to introduce a new priority system on the road.

The current schedule is:

From 30th Sep to 6th Oct - Temporary traffic lights will be put up between the church driveway and the entrance to Smeaton,

From 7th Oct to 18th Oct – The section of Preston Road between the church driveway and the entrance to Smeaton will be closed. Access to the church driveway by car will only be from the High Street / Brown's Place side. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

From 19th Oct to 25th Oct – Temporary traffic lights will be back.
